
**Increase:**

The minutes of the meeting of The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee held on 15.11.2016 confirmed.



22. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at S Nijalingappa Medical College&HSK Hospital&Research Centre, Bagalkot.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (30.09.2016) along with Council Assessor's Report (s) ( June, 2014, 24.03.2015&28.03.2016) and compliance dated 18.05.2016 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 01 seat at S. Nijalingappa Medical College&HSK Hospital&Research Centre, Bagalkot granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (30/09/2016) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2014,24.03.2015&28.03.2016) and compliance dated 18/05/2016 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(Orthopaedics) qualification for 01 seat granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at S. Nijalingappa Medical College&HSK Hospital&Research Centre, Bagalkot be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.
