2. It is to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty, clinical material and stipend to PG students similar to PG students of government colleges in the state etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in regulation of National Medical Commission (NMC).

3. In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permissions of MARB and any misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or found during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not to be considered for recognition of that degree. This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year if such exigency arises.

4. Besides, National Medical Commission (NMC) is entitled to take all such measure against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

5. It is mandatory by government medical colleges to contribute 15% MBBS seats and 50% of post graduate broad specialties (MD/MS) for All India Quota respectively, to MCC of DGHS for conduction of counseling as per the directions of hon'ble Supreme Court.

6. It is mandatory to develop a website of medical college/institution and display all the information

of college, courses offered faculty available and their experience of last 5 years, students joined, and affiliating university to display the hospital services, facilities available and the equipment in each specialty, also showing OP and IP census including births and deaths as per the Municipal/Government records.

7. In case college does not agree with the above decision of MARB, it may prefer an appeal under section 28(5) of NMC Act, 2019 addressed to Secretary NMC within 15 days of this order, through online mode only as per NMC's Public notices dated 21.05.2024 and 30.05.2024.
