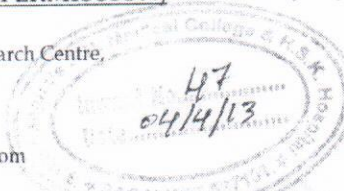

1. Bank Guarantee should be in prescribed format duly signed by two Senior Officers of Bank with stamp and their S. Number.
2. Issuing Bank should be a Commercial Schedule Bank and it shall be mentioned in the Bank Guarantee.
3. No overwriting & cuttings in the Bank Guarantee will be accepted.
4. The Bank Guarantee(s) shall be valid for more than three years (3.5 years) or two year (2.5 years) in case of Degree and diploma course respectively.

In case the Bank Guarantee is already submitted but if not in order or of extra amount will be duly returned on submission of new Bank Guarantee.
